REQUIRED SKILLS AND EXPERIENCE

- Ph.D in Social Sciences
- Track record in teaching and research in topics related to Human Rights
- Solid methodological training
- Academic publications in the field of Human Rights
- Membership of the Mexican National System of Researchers (SNI) or equivalent requirements in order to enter the system once in post

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

General functions include:

- Classroom and virtual lecturing on courses on human rights, sociology and political science.
- Develop research projects to lead to refereed publications
- Supervise, advise and guide postgraduate theses, lead student tutorials, co-ordinate thesis seminars, advise students on their research papers
- Participate in national and international events to present research papers
- Participate in collegiate bodies and academic management

The range of salary will be between \$ 39,885.24 and 53, 674. 96 (in MXN) plus benefits. The category and academic level inside Flacso Mexico's ranking will be assigned based on the successful candidate's academic profile and the regulations established in Flacso's Academic Staff Rules and Regulations.

APPLICATION DOSSIER

Documents:

1. Detailed *Curriculum vitae* highlighting merits, academic qualifications and experience, and suitability for the post.
2. Document accrediting the identity and nationality of the applicant.
3. If the applicant is resident in Mexico and does not hold Mexican nationality, document accrediting migratory status in Mexico.
4. Copies of graduate and postgraduate degrees.
5. Letter of intention stating why the candidate is interested in working at Flacso Mexico (two pages)
6. Two letters of recommendation from prominent academics referring to the candidate's academic trajectory and the relevance of his or her research
7. Copies of the three most representative human rights research papers published by the applicant in the last five years
8. Three year research proposal
9. Human rights teaching proposal

APPLICATION PROCESS

All applicants must submit their application dossier both in hard copy and in digital format on a USB to Flacso Mexico's Dirección Adjunta Académica, located at Carretera al Ajusco No. 377, Col. Heroes de Padierna, Tlalpan 14200, Mexico City, between 10 April and 1 June 2018. No additional documentation will be received after the dossier has been submitted.

If the dossier is sent by mail, it must arrive at Flacso Mexico no later than 1 June 2018.

Shortlisted applicants will be interviewed by the Selection Committee (SC)

Shortlisted applicants will be required to give a class demonstration and a presentation of their research results to academics from Flacso Mexico.

The final decision will be announced by Flacso Mexico's Director General prior to or on 29 June 2018.

Note: The Selection Committee reserves the right not to make an appointment if no suitable candidate is found. Results are final and there is no right of appeal.
